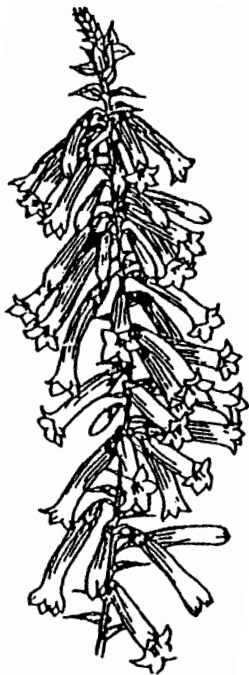
THE KU-RING-GAI WILDFLOWER GARDEN
